# What is a Catalog(ue) Naming Convention?

A catalog naming convention is the name structure of your catalog when loaded into the Ariba Network.

Correct naming conventions (or subscription name) are required when auto sync is active in Ariba Cloud. Auto Sync was activated at Cummins on 30 April 2021.

Cummins naming conventions are:-

Supplier name + Underscore + Country code

*Example*

**ABC INC\_US**

Where a **punchout** catalog is in place, the naming convention would be

**ABC INC PUNCHOUT\_US**

If you have both a cif and punchout catalog in place with Cummins, they would look like this

ABC INC\_US

ABC INC PUNCHOUT\_US

Please ensure your naming convention is correct.
